

BBOB Meeting Minutes October 4, 2021

Scott Wolf: Orchestra is going great. Sectionals are going well. Harp studio, violins cello and bass are all coming in. This week we'll be starting private lessons for students. The Dessert Concert went well for all of us. Our next concert is in 2 weeks. We've had students apply to Allstate Festival. Concerto auditions should be going out within the next 2 weeks.

Alan Posner: Marching Bandwise, the concert went well. It felt like a normal concert, perfect weather. Our festival is on Wednesday. We need volunteers. Jazz Band is back in full swing. We have 40 kids signed up. We will split into 2 jazz bands in late October. We've hired Jimmy Smith to come in 2 days a week to run the second jazz band. We need a bassist, pianist and a couple of trombones. Tri-Em is meeting for the second time this week. This is a music education honor society. The first meeting is 7:15 am on Friday. Festival is Wednesday, Homecoming is Friday. Senior Night coming. It is likely that we will have a home playoff event. This will be in full costume (any costume the kids can play in.)
